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EXEMPT SALES TO STATUS INDIANS TEMPORARY CONFIRMATION OF REGISTRATION DOCUMENT

TEMPORARY CONFIRMATION OF REGISTRATION DOCUMENT

The *Temporary Confirmation of Registration Document* is an official document issued by Indigenous Services Canada to a newly registered individual. This document confirms that the individual named therein is registered as an Indian under the *Indian Act* and is eligible for certain benefits, rights, programs, and services available to Status Indians.

FEATURES OF THE DOCUMENT

Letterhead: This document is printed on Indigenous Services Canada letterhead with a red Canada logo.

Seal: A raised seal of the Indian Registrar is included on the right side of the bottom of the document.

“Valid Until” Date: The document states a “valid until” date, after which it should no longer be used by either the individual or the service provider.

USE OF THE DOCUMENT FOR SASKATCHEWAN SALES TAX PURPOSES

The *Temporary Confirmation of Registration Document* registration number, along with the Status Indian’s name and signature is acceptable proof that the purchaser is a Status Indian and qualifies for an exemption from provincial taxes on reserve, under the federal *Indian Act*. Vendors should confirm the individual’s identity by examining photo identification. Photocopied or altered documents are not acceptable.
